- 1. BIG CHILL'S PRO Dishwasher** is now available in the Vivid finish starting at \$2,145. Equipped with a stamped metal body in chrome or stainless trim, the Energy Star-qualified PRO Dishwasher has a Whisper Quiet Plus (46 dBA) sound reduction, a stainless interior and a hard food disposer within. bigchill.com
- The new **MAYTAG** dishwasher with Dual Power Filtration, 100 percent microfiltration and a four-blade, stainless-steel cutlery tray. The PowerBlast cycle uses high-pressure jets, increased wash temperatures and hot steam, and the PowerDry option provides 99 percent better drying by combining heated drying with a fan for humid air. MSRP ranges from \$799 to \$949. www.maytag.com
- The new dishwasher line from **KITCHENAID** boasts the F Third Rack, which has a deep, angled design that fits 6-in. glasses and bowls. Select models feature two rotating wash jets and a drying bar with tabs that help wick moisture off glasses and removable utensil tray. The dishwashers feature LED lighting provide a 44-dBA sound.
