Best Wine Fridges of 2021



If maintaining accurate temperatures for your wine is your top priority, the **Vinotemp 42-bottle Touchscreen** is the most reliable fridge for you.

During testing conducted by Reviewed, they found that the Vinotemp did the best job cooling the wine to the set temperature against the other top wine fridges on the market. The reviewers loved Vinotemp's single-zone temperature range, which can be set anywhere between 41 and 68 degrees Fahrenheit.

Another feature the reviewers enjoyed is the ability to store wine bottles horizontally, front-to-back so that the labels are front and center. And, they noted that this freestanding nearly-silent fridge also includes a lock which is a nice addition to keep little ones (or perhaps roommates) from accessing your stash.

Cooling Technology

Most of the appliances we evaluated include compressor technology. As Vinotemp—a brand that makes entry-level fridges to high-end cellar-worthy models—explains in [this well-detailed wine refrigerator buying guide](#), the technology is recommended for midsize fridges because it can quickly cool down the unit, maintain a wide temperature range, and the fridge won't be impacted by the temperature of the room where it's placed. Unlike thermoelectric wine coolers—which may be more energy-efficient—where the external temperature can influence how cold the fridge will get.
