## Lesson 2: Invest in Small Appliances with Big Value

When most people think of a kitchen renovation they immediately gravitate to big-ticket appliances like a fancy new range or a sleek new fridge, but I'm here to tell you that for resale value on a home those pricier appliances might not matter as much.

Instead, focus on smaller appliances that add unique dimensions to your home. For our kitchen renovation, we took out a wall which left us with some extra cabinet space so we slotted in a Vinotemp fridge for wine and other beverages (the price for a 12 bottle fridge starts as low as \$299 and goes up from there).

That addition is a new feature that creates the ideal environment for wine, and it's a budget-friendly pick adding yet another feature to your kitchen. Other small appliances that add resale value include cooling and warming drawers, built-in coffee stations, and compact beverage stations.
